Theme: Hmong

Film submission deadline: January 31st, 2016 by 11:59PM

Re-entry submission deadline: February 14th, 2016 by 11:59PM

- Re-entry submission is for films that have been submitted by the deadline, but have not met all the submission requirements, filmmakers will be notified by SHE pab via email.

No entry fee

Submission Requirements:

- Films must be submitted in **MP4** format by the film submission deadline. Not accepting late submissions. If anyone has questions about the format, please email us at shepab@stkate.edu and we will work with you personally to find a solution.
 - Approximately 48 hours after you have completed and submitted your paperwork and film, you will receive an email confirmation.
- Must complete video submission form completely and submit with video.
- Must submit video and submission form together via google drive, email or share it with shepab@stkate.edu.
- The film length must be within 5- 15 minutes, including credits.
- Non-English language films must have English subtitles at the time of submission.
- Videos submitted must be suitable for all ages.
- Videos submitted must be related to our theme: Hmong. For example, videos are related to the culture, tradition, or social justice issues of the Hmong community. The theme is open to interpretation as long as video is deemed appropriate by SHE Pab.
- No edited version of films will be accepted after the re-entry submission deadline.

- Please clarify what you mean by the theme being Hmong?
 - The film Hmong culture, social issue, traditions, current issues, history,
 - You can do your own spin on a myth or folktale.
- Where/who do I submit my video to?
 - Upload your video onto Google drive and share it with SHE Pab at shepab@stkate.edu.
- Can I submit a video that has already been seen in public?
 - Yes, you may.
- Do I have to be Hmong to participate?
 - No you don't. We are open to anyone as long as the video is related to Hmong.
